- Pink STEMI forms will be placed in the EMS room at the hospital for all agencies. Please put these forms in your clipboards on all transporting ambulances.

All state model protocols are now live and current on the MCA website.

- NEW MI-MEDIC cards are out as well, these replace the old versions which need to be removed from the trucks. Anyone having issues with printing them in color please reach out to Nick for help.

NEMMCA protocol 8-13 states that PCR's must be made available to the receiving facilities and the MCA.

- Moving forward PCR's should no longer be faxed to the emergency department fax number.
